Hello and Thanks for your interest.

Below are some answers to our FAQs. I sincerely hope this information compels you to become more involved with our Network as we seek to fill gaps and build bridges of people skills and expertise across our nation for good works.

What is the history and service record of Many Waters Resource Network?

*We incorporated two organizations in 2000.
Many Waters and The Jesusis4 Foundation.*

Many Waters provides services to Engineering Industry in 4 categories

- 1.) Locating individuals for contract assignments, direct hire and specific project teams*
- 2.) Locating companies for specific project teams*
- 3.) Marketing small companies to larger companies*
- 4.) Partnering and Teaming Facilitation*

The Foundation provides tax exempt services in 4 areas.

- 1.) Provides Volunteer Engineers for Disaster Response (for expl. we sent over 60 engineers to Katrina)*
- 2.) Provides Emergency Communications (for example we presented awards in India to the radio operators that we trained who provided all the EMCOM assistance for the first two weeks following the 2004 Tsunami)*
- 3.) Provide water filtration systems to over 3400 impoverished families in the Philippines (This falls into our International Missions category)*
- 4.) Provide volunteer design build services to Drug and Alcohol Rehabilitation (We are building a 11,200 Sf Industrial Soup Kitchen for a local cost free residential rehab center whose residents have been eating outside in the weather since 1979)*

Are you associated with any other business or organization?

Yes- we are all about Networking!!! We are directly partnered with DERA, the Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Response Association, Int'l (been around since 1962, www.disasters.org I am on their Board and also serve as their National Disaster Operations Director. We primarily provide Emergency Communications with their equipment and resources)

We have been sustaining members of the American Society of Military Engineers www.same.org for 4 years and are also partnered with certain large engineering firms on specific proposals on the For Profit side of things. That information is rather on the confidential side.

We are also partnered with some other For Profits and Non-Profits for specific proposals engaging in Disaster Response, CEU and PDH credentialing and course certification, and Small Business Mentoring and Advocacy.

Tell me about your staff and resources.

Staff- very small only 3 of us. but that equals low overhead.

Resources- I consider each individual to be our greatest resource- especially those with more significant experience. We currently have 15,138 people across almost EVERY Engineering discipline (except automotive and aerospace) also Architects, Planners, Scientists and Construction Managers. We are preferred members of one of the top ranked recruiting networks in the country for engineering and medical. (both good fits for the disaster category) It is called Top Echelon. Through that membership we also have access to over 5000 open jobs and over 1 millions individuals.

It is because of the Networking capabilities of both the For Profit and the Non Profit that we believe we can make a significant impact in all our Initiatives. We have a constant stream of new engineers both PEs and EITs who contribute to an ever growing group.
